The KCAA is in the process of reviewing the current Aviation Security Regulations in line with ICAO Annex 17 and Annex 9 Security related aspects of facilitation latest amendments, at the same time addressing regulatory requirements in compliance with ICAO Universal Security Audit Programme-Continuous Monitoring Approach.

The Authority has finalised incorporation of the revised amendments and requirements in all the critical elements of an Aviation Security Oversight System to the affected set of Kenya Civil Aviation Security Regulations and developed a draft civil aviation regulations.
